Message



St. Paul was once a persecutor of the first-century church. Despite his past as a blasphemer and a violent man, Paul was shown mercy because he acted in ignorance and unbelief. In 1 Timothy 1:14, he acknowledges, 'The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.' Let us briefly examine Paul's journey through three small headings:

1. Who are you, Lord?

Paul's faith journey began with a miraculous encounter with God on the road to Damascus. When God spoke to Paul, his first question was, 'Who are you, Lord?' This can be considered the question of salvation. Many in the Christian world may profess faith but lack a personal understanding of who Jesus is. Just as the Samaritan woman, despite her knowledge of faith and tradition, found true satisfaction only through a personal encounter with Jesus, knowing Jesus personally is fundamental to the Christian faith.

2. What should I do?

Once we know Jesus, the next question is, 'What should I do?' Faith in Jesus without obedience to God's will is meaningless. Living solely for worldly pursuits without consideration for eternity is a pitiful existence (1 Corinthians 15:19). Jesus himself warned against being mere 'evil doers' by missing God's will (Matthew 7:21-23). Living according to God's will offers hope and joy for eternity.

3. Job description of Paul

God has a specific purpose for each of us. We cannot live solely according to our desires but must align ourselves with God's plan. Paul recognized this when he said he worked with his hands for his income (Acts 20:34). However, God's job description for Paul was clear: 'This man is my chosen instrument to proclaim my name to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel' (Acts 9:15). This aligns with the command to 'make disciples of all nations.' The call to follow Jesus entails denying ourselves, taking up the cross (God's plan), and following Him. Will we choose to follow Jesus?"

Testimony



I am S. David Solomon, originally from Madurai, Tamil Nadu. In 2006, I married Selva Dani, and together we have two children, David Livingston and Beautlin Sweety. My father, Samuel, was a Christian, but my mother, Panchavarnam, was not. However, after their marriage, my mother developed a strong interest in Jesus Christ. When I was just two years old and seriously ill, the doctors were unable to heal me. Desperate, my mother turned to prayer at the nearby Evangelical church. With tearful supplication, she pleaded for my healing, and miraculously, God answered her prayers. This early experience marked the beginning of God's calling on my life.

Growing up in Madurai, Tamil Nadu, a friend introduced me to the India Church Growth Mission, where I began attending services regularly. On October 10th, 1994,

during a sermon by Pastor Dharmar on Matthew 4:17, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand," I was deeply convicted of my sins. Overwhelmed with remorse, I spent a sleepless night in repentance, eventually finding solace in accepting Jesus Christ as my personal Saviour. I realized the profound sacrifice Jesus made on the cross for my sins, and through confession and repentance, I experienced the cleansing of my sins.

Upon sharing my experience with my pastor, he explained that this was the born-again experience, referencing John 3:1-16. Filled with joy, I eagerly participated in church activities and received baptism on October 30th.

Following my completion of 12th grade, God called me to full-time ministry, affirming this through Exodus 33:17, "This very thing that you have spoken, I will do, for you have found favour in my sight, and I know you by name." Embracing this divine call, I embarked on a ministry journey, serving in village communities through the India Church Growth Mission.
